How do I enrol at Tollbar Sixth Form?

- **When do I enrol?**

You can enrol any time after receiving your GCSE results on **Thursday 20th August**.

- **How do I enrol?**

We will be offering three ways in which you can enrol:

- 1. Face-to-face with a member of the Sixth Form team here at the college.**

Enrolment will take place in a Covid-secure environment. Your route to the enrolment area will be well signposted. On arrival you will be guided to complete enrolment paperwork and receive information regarding the new academic year.

External applicants should enter the Academy through the Sixth Form entrance and follow the signposts.

Beyond 12pm, applicants can report to Tollbar Academy's main reception and request a member of the Sixth Form team. **Only the applicant is permitted on site.**
