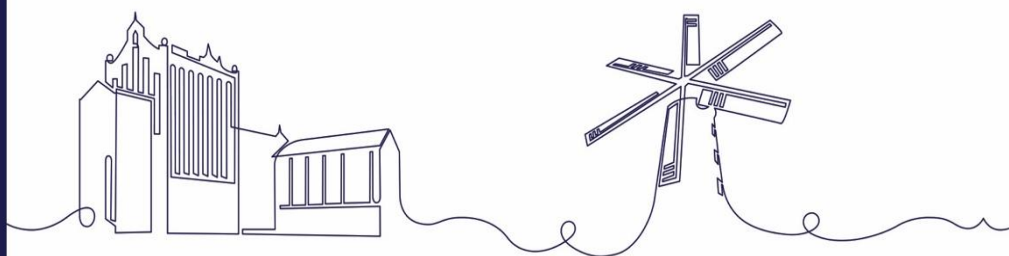


Aspirational Alumni

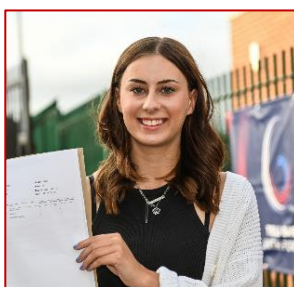
