Year 12 Parental Consultation Evening

Year 12 End of Year Examinations

These are scheduled to take place for two weeks from Monday 17 June 2024. These examinations are incredibly important, as they not only provide us with valuable information regarding student progress over the year, but they are also used to inform predicted grades for the purpose of UCAS applications and other opportunities that students may wish to apply for in Year 13. We ask for your support in ensuring that students approach these examinations with the right mindset is much appreciated.

Year 12 Work Experience

Our Year 12 students will be completing work experience between 1 - 5 July 2024. Students are currently approaching employers and exploring destinations under the guidance of their tutor and our careers team.
